## Kindergarten Registration for September, 2018

Applications are being accepted from students wanting to attend Lakeview in 2018/19.

If your child was born in 2013, he/she can begin school in September. When registering, the school requires the following information:

- **Proof of birth date** for the student (birth certificate or passport).
  - **Proof of guardianship** (as shown on birth certificate or other legal documentation).
  - **Proof of citizenship** for both parent and student (Canadian birth certificate, citizenship card, PR card).
  - **Proof of residency**  
**Cat A** - proof of ownership of dwelling or rental agreement or income tax return **and**  
**Cat B** - utility bill or driver's licence.
  - **Record of immunization.**
- Please pass this information on to families who do not have a student attending Lakeview.
