- 3. Give <u>prior</u> notice (when possible and as soon as possible) when unable to attend a practice or game. A written note from a parent is preferred.
- 4. Be respectful to themselves, teammates, coaches, parents, officials at the games, and athletes from other schools.
- 5. Behave at practices and games in a manner that represents themselves and the school in a positive way.
- 6. Behave at school in a manner that is consistent with the school's Code of Conduct.
- 7. Act respectful to peers, classmates and staff of the school.
- 8. Complete all assignments on time for your classroom teachers.
- 9. Behave appropriately in any other situation not listed.

## **CONSEQUENCES**

- 1. Students may be dropped from the team or miss shifts during games for the following reasons:
  - ✓ Two unexcused absences from practice.

  - ✓ Unacceptable behaviour at practice.
