6. Behave at school in a manner that is consistent with the school's Code of Conduct.
7. Act respectful to peers, classmates and staff of the school.
8. Complete all assignments on time for your classroom teachers.
9. Behave appropriately in any other situation not listed.

CONSEQUENCES
