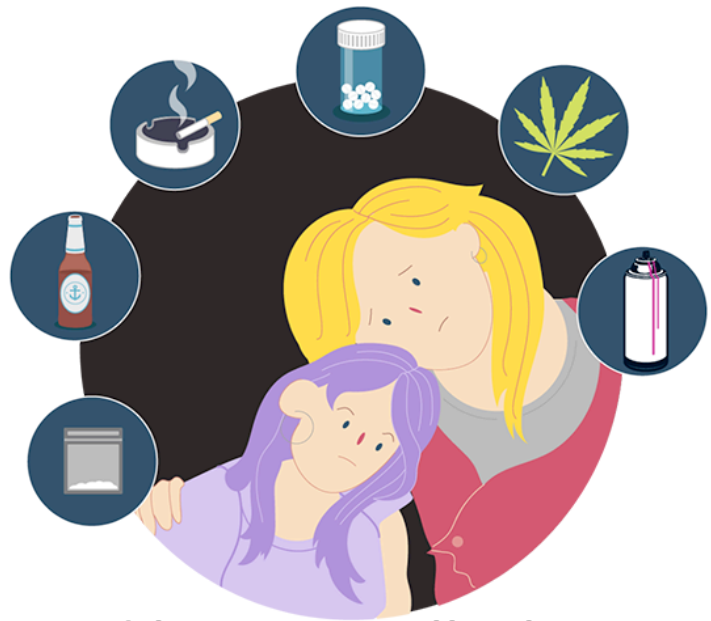


Parent Information Night

- The importance of decreasing stigma when talking about substance use and addiction.

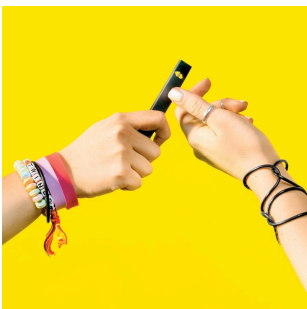

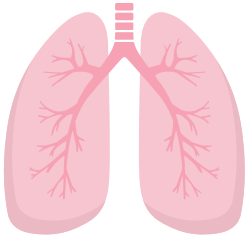
