EXPECTATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Students who join Basketball are expected to:

1. Come to practices and games dressed appropriately for running.
2. Come to practice and be ready to begin on time (8:00 am)
3. Give prior notice (when possible and as soon as possible) when unable to attend a practice or game. A written note from a parent is preferred.
4. Be respectful to themselves, teammates, coaches, parents, officials at the games, and athletes from other schools.
5. Behave at practices and games in a manner that represents themselves and the school in a positive way.
6. Behave at school in a manner that is consistent with the school's Code of Conduct.
7. Act respectful to peers, classmates and staff of the school.
8. Complete all assignments on time for your classroom teachers.
9. Behave appropriately in any other situation not listed.

CONSEQUENCES

1. Students may be dropped from the team or miss shifts during games for the following reasons:
 - ✓ Two unexcused absences from practice.
 - ✓ Habitually late coming to practice.
 - ✓ Unacceptable behaviour at practice.
 - ✓ Unacceptable behaviour at school.
