On Monday, March 2nd, Divisions 6, 7, 8, and 9 were treated to a wonderful presentation by Mr. Tony Hardie of the Mobile Museum. Mr. Hardie shared a Powerpoint, along with a large selection of artifacts collected over 40 years. He had some masks, harpoons, glass beads, cedar hats and baskets, along with a wide selection of handmade tools used for hammering, slicing and cutting. The students also had the opportunity to feel beaver, mink, hare, weasel, skunk and raccoon pelts! There was also the opportunity to view a number of masks made by local Elders and examine the intricate cedar weaving done by some Coast Salish women. It was so special to be able to see the actual artifacts in real life and not just a picture.
