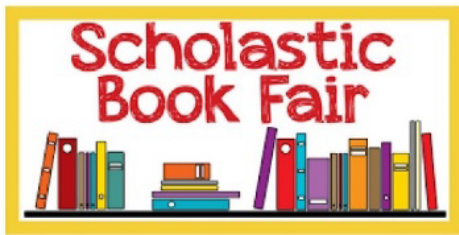


## Library Stats!
