

Government of Canada Travel Quarantine and Requirements:

5-11-year-olds

• Unvaccinated and partially vaccinated children under 12 years of age can travel with fully vaccinated parent/guardians. However, they must follow specific requirements when they return to Canada, which includes that they must not attend school for 14 days upon return to Canada. • This includes if the trip is under 72 hours.

12-17-year-olds

- Fully vaccinated 12–17-year-olds follow the same requirements as adults.
- While there are some exemptions for 12–17-year-olds who are not fully vaccinated to travel, most international travel (including domestic and international flights departing from most airports in Canada) requires travellers 12 years of age and older to be fully vaccinated.
- Unvaccinated and partially vaccinated youth 12 to 17 years of age who have travelled internationally are subject to 14-day quarantine and specific testing requirements. They must not attend school for 14 days upon return to Canada. o This includes if the trip is under 72 hours.

We have added to our collection continually, with students voicing their requests and recommendations on a regular basis.

With over 150 books circulating for each day that Ms. Buchanan is in the library, over 50 new books added per month, and books on hold delivered to students daily, we give thanks for a library that is an active space.
