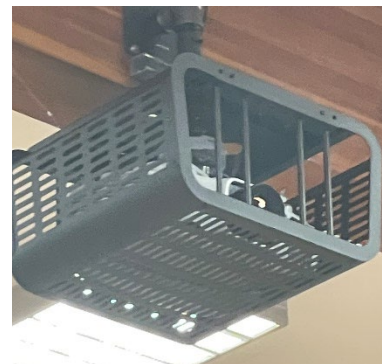
Track is back:
