We are limiting attendance to our intermediate classes and immediate family only.

What will our First Week Activities look like:
Growth Mindset – All year we will be focusing as a school on having a Growth Mindset and the weeks activities will be strengthening the concept to all of us as a community. As the year progresses, we will dig deeper into core ideas about Growth Mindset.

Dismissal from new temporary classroom (we will have lists about pickup location).

Thursday September 8th and Friday September 9th. 8:55-3:00 on Thursday, 2:00 on Friday

Start and end each day at new temporary classes and continue with rotations.

Gradual Entry Schedule

During the first weeks of school, Kindergarten students will have a gradual entry schedule to help them adjust to the routines and expectations of Kindergarten (see below).

Tuesday, September 6

All Kindergarten students attend from 9:00 to 10:00. We will meet in Ms. Knapp's classroom (modular classroom beside the parking lot).

Wednesday, September 7, Thursday, September 8, and Friday, September 9

Group A attends from 8:55 – 10:30; Group B attends from 1:30–3:00

- On Friday, September 9, parents will sign-up for an intake interview with their child's classroom teacher

Monday, September 12 and Tuesday, September 13

- Intake Conversations 9:00–11:00 and 1:00–3:00. Students do not attend school on these days but are invited to come to the intake meeting.

Wednesday, September 14

-students attend from 8:55 – 11:00 (students will need a healthy snack, **NO** nut products)

Thursday, September 15

-students attend from 8:55 – 1:30 (students will need a healthy snack and a lunch, **NO** nut products)

Friday, September 16

-students attend from 8:55 – 2:00 (students will need a healthy snack and a lunch, **NO** nut products)

Monday, September 19 and every day after

-students attend from 8:55 – 3:00 (students will need a healthy snack and a lunch, **NO** nut products)
