## **June 24 – Sports Day**

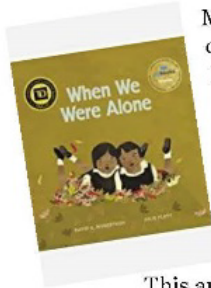

In addition, he is a two-time winner of the prestigious Governor General's Literary Awards. His novel, Barren Grounds, is not only a Red Cedar Award Nominee this year, but is also one of the

Mr. Robertson responded to individual questions formed by our students: Hena, Kiana, Kushal, Reya, Shayla, and Victoria, but also extended our understanding of his work by sharing parts of his journey and identity as a Cree person in Canada. His dialogue about the importance of our children and youth in the changing views and understanding of Indigenous peoples left a lasting impression on us.
