Vaisakhi is traditionally the spring harvest festival celebrated across northern India. It takes on extra significance for Sikhs as it also aligns with important events which shaped the religion. This includes in 1699 when Guru Gobind Singh established the Khalsa Order to create a temporal leadership and to protect the innocent from oppression and uphold freedom for all people. Vaisakhi is celebrated by coming together as a community, sharing with one another, and participating in the Nagar Kirtan parade.

To celebrate Vaisakhi at Lakeview, students are welcome to come into school in punjabi attire on Thursday April 13th. Please ensure it is comfortable wear as they will be wearing it for the whole day. We look forward to seeing the colorful and fancy outfits!
