Spelexilh is a traditional wool weaver, knowledge keeper, storyteller, and Indigenous Educator. Blanketing is accorded significance Indigenous ceremony and culture.

A blanketing ceremony shows our respect for those who have made an important contribution to the community in some way. The respected guest is draped with special blankets in front of witnesses, and it is theirs to keep. Paige and Alyssa have shared their artwork and their stories through the images that they created in honour of National Truth and Reconciliation Day. Their contributions and Alyssa's graduation from Lakeview Elementary School will be honoured in this blanketing ceremony.
