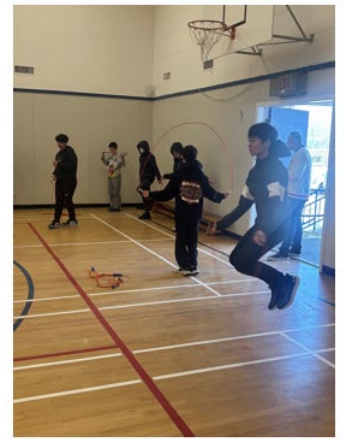


Jump Rope for Heart 2025
