On Wednesday, February 26th we will recognize Pink Shirt Day. This year's theme is "Let Kindness Grow." We will be creating a shared art display at the entry of the school where every student will contribute; we will also be exploring the theme in our assembly Wednesday afternoon.

The first Pink Shirt Day was organized in 2007 by David Shepherd and Travis Price of Berwick, Nova Scotia. After a male Grade 9 student, Charles McNeill, was threatened and harassed for wearing a pink shirt during the first day of school, the two students took a stand against homophobic bullying when they bought and distributed 50 pink shirts at their school. In Canada, we recognize Pink Shirt Day annually on the last Wednesday of February as way to challenge harmful stereotypes and encourage people to speak up when we hear name-calling or discrimination.

Pink Shirt Day reminds students that they can:

- Play any sport, game or with any toy
- Play with children of any gender
- Wear any colour and style of clothes or hair
- Be who they are and help others do the same
- Stand up to name-calling and discrimination to make a difference
