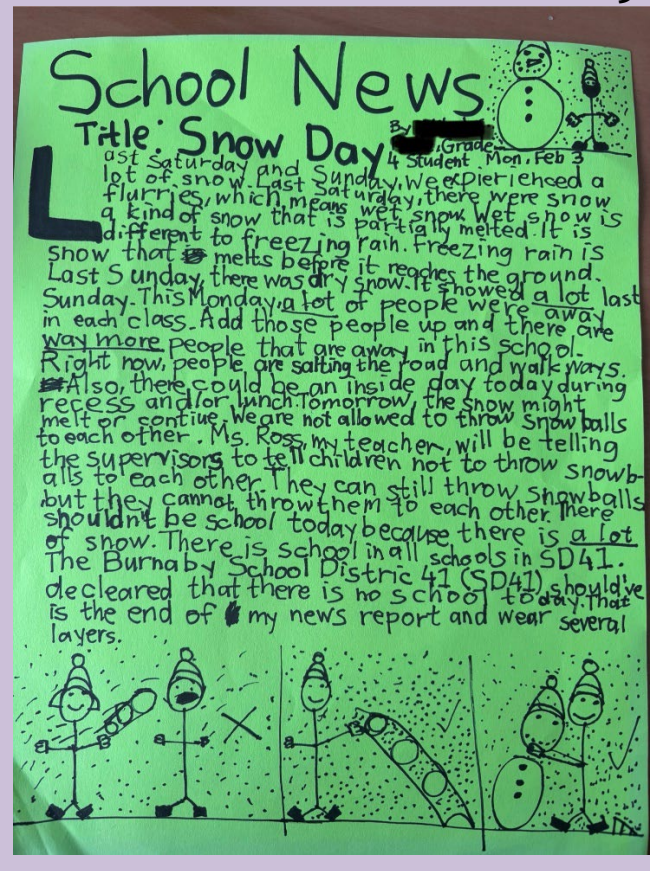

Dear Lakeview Families,

We're participating in Jump Rope for Heart



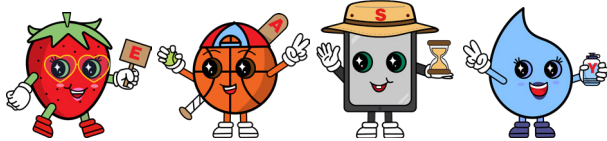
Dear Parents/Guardians,

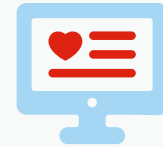
