▶ TUITION-FREE?

Elementary students who meet the following criteria are eligible to take **one tuition-free morning academic course**. All afternoon activity programs are fee paying.

Your child must:

- be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident or convention refugee
- have attended a BC school in the 2024-2025 school year and ordinarily reside in BC with a parent/guardian
- □ have a BC Personal Education Number (PEN)

Those not eligible, or those signing up for courses requiring fees can pay by Visa or Mastercard.

<u>NOTE:</u> Transfers & refund requests must be made by noon on July 7.

▶ Learning Support

If your child has an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) and/or a Fraser Health Care Plan and is currently receiving additional learning support provided by an Education Assistant (EA) at school, we encourage you to complete the online registration **by May 3** to evaluate the level of support necessary for your child. Registration decisions will be made until the **middle of June**.

Please be sure to have the following documents ready during the online registration process:

- Proof of student's birthdate: birth certificate or passport
- Proof of guardianship: parents' or guardians' as shown on birth certificate or other appropriate legal documentation such as landed immigrant papers or guardianship "order" granted by the courts
- Proof of citizenship for both parent and the student: Canadian birth certificate, citizenship card, passport, landed immigrant document, permanent resident card
- Proof of residency of the parent/guardian and student. Two pieces required, with at least one being from Category A:
 - Category A: proof of ownership of dwelling (i.e. purchase contract, property assessment, annual municipal utility/tax statement); long term lease/ rental agreement; parent or guardian's income tax return or notice of assessment from Revenue Canada
 - Category B: BC Hydro bill, BC cable bill, provincial driver's license, provincial registration of automobile, Canadian bank account or credit card statement
- Copy of student's most recent school marks: report card or transcript of academic record
- BC Personal Education Number (PEN)

Upon approval, you will receive notification about your eligibility to register for Summer Session courses with the Burnaby School District.

Adventures in Music

Come and spend your mornings playing with music! A variety of methods will be used to learn music. You will play musical games outside and then come inside to play rhythms and melodies on a variety of instruments.

Adventures in Reading

Develop an appreciation for the enjoyment of literature, increase confidence with printed word, and explore different types of genres as you journey into the world of reading.

Art

These classes are teacher specific and will vary in content depending on the passion of the teacher. Projects may include drawing, painting, printmaking, image development, stitch work, clay work, or sewing.

Bandlab

This course focuses on teaching essential skills in recording, beat-making, and music creation, utilizing Bandlab or Digital Audio Workstation (DAW). The program will provide students with a beginning foundation in digital music and audio production.

Beginner Ultimate Frisbee

Come and learn a game you can play for the rest of your life! The focus will be on physical wellness, sportsmanship and learning basic skills to play Ultimate Frisbee. Be prepared to be outside running everyday!

Beginner Guitar

Learn the basics of playing an acoustic guitar. Learn how to play chords, count rhythms and beats, and how to pick notes as you work to perform a number of pop songs.

Brain Gymnastics - French Immersion
