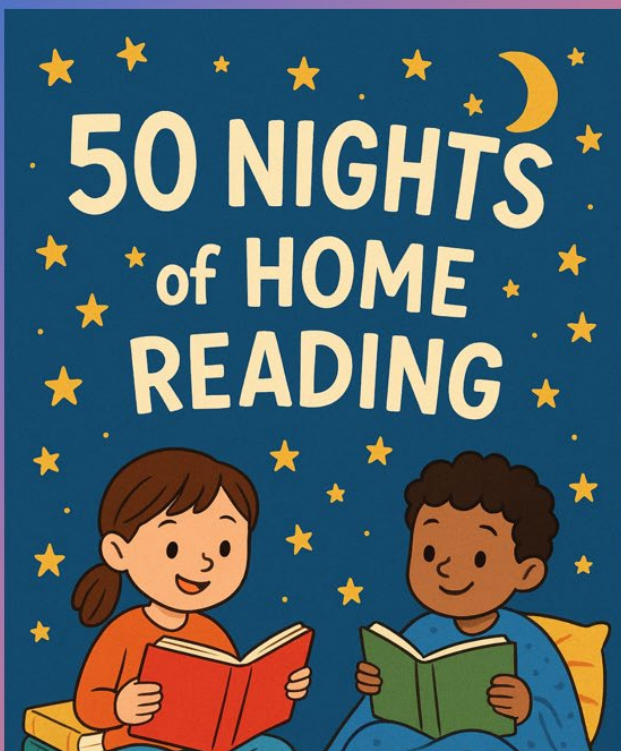

Lakeview PAC Family Photo Night Fundraiser

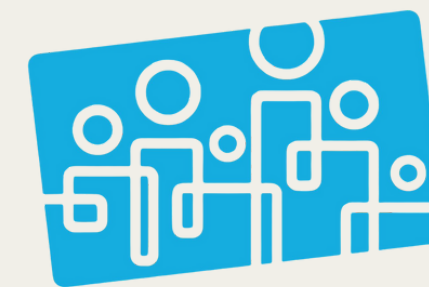

Identification for Each Child

- ie. birth certificate, passport

Proof of Income

- Each parent/guardian show 2024 Proof of Income/Release of Information

Arrival by car

From the Willingdon South exit, turn left on Kingsway, and Metropolis at Metrotown will have multiple access points. Park for free for a maximum of 4 hours. Then take the elevator to the Upper Level (UP2) and head to Winners as it is right next to the Toy Room.

Arrival by Skytrain

Depart at Metrotown Skytrain station, cross Central Boulevard street, enter the mall and head towards Winners on the Upper Level (UP2), you will find the Toy Room to the right of Winners.

UBC Dental Program

Dental Treatment for Children Ages 0-12 without Dental Coverage

Children may be eligible to receive free dental care with the UBC Children's Dental Program.

- Supervised UBC dental students ("dentist or dental hygienist in training") provide dental exams and treatment
- A parent / caregiver must accompany their child to the appointments
- Appointments are Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons at: UBC, Noble Biocare Oral Health Centre, 2151 Wesbrook Mall UBC Campus, Vancouver.
- School bus transportation is available for families who need a ride to and from the UBC dental clinic.
