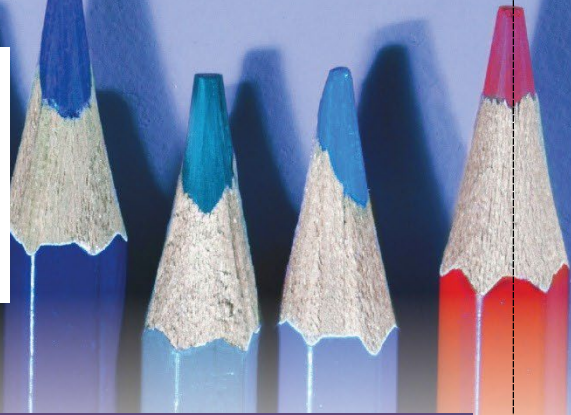

Discuss Areas for Improvement: Approach these conversations with empathy and encouragement. Ask your child how they feel about their progress and what support they might need.

Set Goals Together: Collaborate with your child to set realistic and achievable goals for the next term. This helps them take ownership of their learning.

Stay Involved: Regularly check in on their progress and maintain open lines of communication with their teachers.
