### **Principal Report**

-School enrollment was at 291 in October 2025

-currently at 292

-Grade 6 and 7 classes are full

-some space in other grades

-February was enrollment month

-school numbers look steady for the Fall

-currently processing cross district/boundary requests and new requests to Lakeview

-January Literacy Week was a huge success with focus on student writing

-Principal Poitras appreciates the generosity of families were in fundraising

-Principal Poitras is looking for an Accessibility Committee for the school

-The District Committee found the following strengths at Lakeview: the Gym and Classrooms are accessible and comfortable

-Lakeview has one bathroom with accessibility on main floor

Areas of Improvement: Posted sign in Parking lot, Hallways are cluttered, parking lot has a barrier, no automatic door openers, uneven surface, stair tread needs repair, outdoor play equipment is not accessible due to surfacing, the school needs more sensory spaces available to all,

-Low/No Cost Fixes the school can do: improve hallway organization, adding QR codes, fixing Library carpeting, fixing toilet paper holder in Modular bathroom to allow student access, improve stage accessibility,

#### District Literacy Intensive Teacher: Mandy Yip:

-new district position

-Ms. Yip wrapped up working with students

-is now working with staff

-is available to do a parent workshop about how to support children over the summer

#### Report Cards:

-March reports will be the last paper reports

-parents will access reports through parent portal from June onwards

-Principal Poitras will meet with staff after Spring Break to explain this process

-staff will help parents navigate

-parents with high school aged kids will have access to elementary school reports at the same location

#### **Treasurer Update (Davina):**

-Funds are in 'good shape'

-The Gaming Account has \$8700 and \$18000 in the General Account

-In April Davina will re apply for the school grant

#### **Hot Lunch Update (Allison):**

- No bubble tea this upcoming term. They raised their prices by \$1
- All the same vendors will be part of our Hot Lunch program this last term

### **Miscellaneous/Parent Question**
